Step 1: Pre-Session Phone Call

We'll kick things off with a brief, no-obligation <u>Discovery Call</u> where you can share a bit about the pets being photographed, your goals for the session and ask any questions you may have. This is an informational call - no sales pitch and no pressure!

Step 2: Booking

Once you've decided that Stephanie Lynne Photography is the right fit, it's time to <u>Book Your Session</u>. You'll receive a Proposal with all of the details, including a contract and invoice for the \$299 Reservation Retainer.

Remember, this is a non-refundable deposit that becomes product credit at your Viewing & Ordering Appointment.

Step 3: Session Day

Yay! Session Day is your dog's time to shine. Before this day, I will be in touch with you to learn more about everyone being photographed, help you choose a location, and finalize all of the details. Your dog's only job is to be a dog and your only job is to have fun and enjoy the experience!

- About two weeks after the session, we will meet in person at the studio for your <u>Viewing & Ordering Appointment</u>. This is your time to sit back, snack on some fresh, homemade chocolate chip cookies, and take in a slide show of your session. Then I'll walk you through the options as we decide how you'll most enjoy your images, often through a combination of wall art, albums, prints & digital files.
- I will have sample products available for you to view during this appointment to help you decide. Payment plans are available.
- Once your products are ready, I will contact you to arrange for in-person delivery. Complimentary installation of wall pieces is available upon request. You're going to love your new artwork!

Frequently Asked



My dog doesn't know sit or stay. Is that a problem?

Not at all! Some of my favorite portraits are of dogs standing up. Rest assured, I have a deep well of unique sounds and tasty treats to grab their attention—even if it's just for that split second while I capture each image.

My dog can't be off leash. Can I still do a session?

Yes! Absolutely! Believe it or not, most of the dogs that I photograph are on leash. Leashes not only keep your best pal safe, but they're also important for following local laws when photographing in urban environments. Thanks to the wizardry of Photoshop, leashes will be removed from most final images.

What about harnesses or gentle leaders, can those be edited out?

Well, Photoshop does have its limitations. Super-bulky harnesses hide so much of the dog's chest that it's very challenging to accurately rebuild those pixels in post-production. Gentle leaders can leave unsightly shadows or pull on the dog's skin, so those are also a challenge to digitally remove. If your dog normally wears one of these for walks, I recommend using it while walking to our location, but also bringing a flat collar to use for the actual shoot. If you need to stick with the harness or gentle leader but would like it edited from final images, there is an additional retouching fee. However, digital removals for leashes, regular flat collars and martingale collars are always included.

My dog is reactive to other dogs/people/bicycles. How can we do a session?

I completely understand. If your dog is nervous or reactive, we can choose a location that suits his temperament. I have a few out-of-the-way locations that receive very little dog or foot traffic, or we can rent a private location for a small fee, ensuring that we see won't see a soul.

My dog is camera shy. How do you manage nervous or timid dogs?

I understand shy pets very well. Not to worry! Our photo session will not be rushed, so if your pet needs a little extra time to feel comfortable, we can accommodate that. On photo day, I will keep your session low stress...no posing necessary! And I can shoot from a distance to capture those treasured moments between you and your pet.

Do you photograph pets other than dogs?

You bet! All pets can be included in your personalized session. While the majority of my clients are dogs and puppies, I welcome clients with other types of pets as well!

Do you photography puppies?

As a matter of fact, I do! Many clients even book two or three sessions during puppy's first year to capture all the special moments and then create custom wall art, a Keepsake Album or a beautiful Story Box for those treasured memories.

Can I be in the images, too?

Of course! Capturing the bond between pets and the people they love is what Stephanie Lynne Photography is all about! While we can certainly capture a traditional portrait of you both smiling at the camera, my clients especially love the candid images of the moments you share. If you're camera shy, I can still create some lovely, creative images that tell the story of your relationship. Please just trust me and remember that you don't need to purchase or display any images that you don't adore.

What time will our photo session be?

The best times of day for outdoor photography are during the "golden hours" - shortly after sunrise or before sunset. But I can work around your schedule to photograph any time of day - and indoor studio sessions are available as well.

How do I choose a location?

During our session planning, we will discuss the look you're after, any special needs your dog might have (mobility challenges, anxiety, etc.) and scheduling constraints on your part (e.g. mornings only). With all that in mind, we will settle on the perfect location for your custom session.

What if it's raining?

If the weather is less than ideal, we can definitely reschedule. Your reservation retainer simply transfers over to our new session date. We can even build in a "rain date" during our initial consultation and planning to cover this possibility.

Who can come to the session?

Everyone who lives in your household (furry or not) is welcome to participate in our session. In the interest of minimizing distractions, however, I do ask that only those who will be in the photos come along. If you're interested in holding a session with pets outside of your household or your extended family, I'd be happy to put together a custom quote.

Do you offer sessions for elderly or terminally ill pets?

Facing the end of a pet's life can be one of the most difficult times for families. I offer a <u>Celebration of Life Session</u> for these moments. This session takes place where the pet will be most comfortable and can usually be scheduled on short notice. Capturing beautiful moments between a family and their beloved pets is a beautiful tribute to your best friend and your treasured memories.
